

Epidemiological Factors Influencing IVF

Outcome: Evidence from the Yale IVF Program

This epidemiologic study of the Yale IVF program 1996-2002 looked at 297 patients, controlling for race, BMI and medical problems and found that alcohol consumption was not linked to IVF outcome. The only consistent factor noted to impact outcome was AGE.
